House Local Bill No. 21-9, D1

A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate funds specifically allotted to the Second Senatorial District under Public Law 18-30, as amended; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- The purpose of this Act is to appropriate Sixty-Two Thousand dollars (\$62,000.00
- 3 USD) of the funds specifically allotted to the Second Senatorial District under Public Law No.
- 4 18-13 as amended, for personnel and operations of Office of the Mayor of the Municipality of
- 5 Tinian and Aguiguan and the supplemental medical assistance program.

6 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.

- There is hereby appropriated Sixty-Two Thousand dollars (\$62,000.00 USD) of the
- 8 funds allotted to the Second Senatorial District under Public Law No. 18-30 as amended, to be
- 9 expended by the Office of the Mayor of Tinian and Aguiguan for personnel and operations and
- the supplemental medical assistance program.

SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.

- The expenditure authority for all funds appropriated under this Act shall be the Mayor
- of Tinian and Aguiguan.

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SECTION 4. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS.

- Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the Secretary of the Department of Finance
- 3 shall transfer the funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act to an account set up by the
- 4 Tinian Municipal Treasurer within ten calendar days of the effective date of this Act. The
- 5 Tinian Municipal Treasurer shall regulate and control the funds appropriated under this Act so
- 6 that no activity may spend contrary to this Act or fiscal management policies of the
- 7 Municipality or Commonwealth of Northern Mariana Islands.

8 SECTION 5. FISCAL YEAR.

- 9 The funds appropriated under this Act shall be appropriated without fiscal year
- 10 limitation(s).

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11 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.

- If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any person or
- circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remainder of this
- 14 Act or the application of its provisions to persons or circumstances other than those to which it
- is held invalid shall not be affected thereby.

16 SECTION 7. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

- 17 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as affecting any
- 18 existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes repealed or under any rule,
- 19 regulation or order adopted under the statutes. Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect
- any proceeding instituted under or pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not
- 21 have the effect of terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which
- shall already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective.

1	SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE.
2	This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law
3	without such approval.
