A LOCAL APPROPRIATION BILL FOR AN ACT FOR THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT

To appropriate \$92,000 from the local license fees collected for pachinko slot machines and poker machines in the Second Senatorial District; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE SECOND SENATORIAL DISTRICT DELEGATION PURSUANT TO CHAPTER 4, DIVISION 1, TITLE 1 OF THE COMMONWEALTH CODE:

1 SECTION 1. PURPOSE.

- 2 The purpose of this Act is to appropriate Ninety-Two Thousand dollars
- 3 (\$92,000.00 USD) collected from the local license fees for pachinko slot machines
- 4 and poker machines for personnel and operations of the Office of the Mayor of the
- 5 Municipality of Tinian and Aguiguan.
- 6 SECTION 2. APPROPRIATIONS.
- 7 There is hereby appropriated Ninety-Two Thousand dollars (\$92,000.00
- 8 USD) from the local license fees for pachinko slot machines and poker machines,
- 9 pursuant to 10 CMC § 2471, to be expended by the Office of the Mayor of Tinian

1 and Aguiguan for personnel and operations.

2 SECTION 3. EXPENDITURE AUTHORITY.

- The expenditure authority for all funds appropriated under this Act shall be
- 4 the Mayor of Tinian.

5 SECTION 4. MANAGEMENT OF FUNDS.

- Notwithstanding any law to the contrary, the Secretary of the Department
- 7 of Finance shall transfer the funds appropriated under Section 2 of this Act to an
- 8 account set up by the Tinian Municipal Treasurer within ten calendar days of the
- 9 effective date of this Act. The Tinian Municipal Treasurer shall regulate and
- 10 control the funds appropriated under this Act so that no activity may spend contrary
- 11 to this Act or fiscal management policies of the Municipality or Commonwealth of
- 12 Northern Mariana Islands.

13 SECTION 5. FISCAL YEAR.

- The funds appropriated under this Act shall be appropriated without fiscal
- 15 year limitation(s).

16 SECTION 6. SEVERABILITY.

- 17 If any provision of this Act or the application of any such provision to any
- person or circumstance should be held invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction,
- 19 the remainder of this Act or the application of its provisions to persons or
- 20 circumstances other than those to which it is held invalid shall not be affected
- 21 thereby.

SECTION 7. SAVINGS CLAUSE.

1

2 This Act and any repealer contained herein shall not be construed as

3 affecting any existing right acquired under contract or acquired under statutes

4 repealed or under any rule, regulation or order adopted under the statutes.

5 Repealers contained in this Act shall not affect any proceeding instituted under or

6 pursuant to prior law. The enactment of the Act shall not have the effect of

terminating, or in any way modifying, any liability, civil or criminal, which shall 7

already be in existence on the date this Act becomes effective. 8

SECTION 8. EFFECTIVE DATE. 9

This Act shall take effect upon its approval by the Governor or upon its 10

11 becoming law without such approval.
