H. L. B. No. 18-33

To name the public beach located behind the San Antonio Elementary School in San Antonio, Saipan (Lot Nos. 004 I 26, 002 I 43, 002 I 42), to “San Antonio Village Beach Park”; and for other purposes. Introduced by Rep. Antonio P. Sablan of Saipan, Precinct 1 (*for himself*) on October 18, 2013.

H. B. No. 18-139

To require government employees convicted of a felony to be terminated and employees charged with a felony to be terminated or suspended without pay. Introduced by REP. ANTONIO P. H. B. No. 18-140

To amend Public Law No. 17-43 to give the Commonwealth Office of Transit Authority (COTA) the power to adopt rules and regulations in furtherance of its duties; and for other purposes. Introduced by REP. ANTONIO P. SABLAN of Saipan, Precinct 1 (*for himself*) on October 24, 2013, referred to the Committee on Public Utilities, Transportation, and Communications.

H. B. No. 18-141

To legalize drag racing within the Commonwealth of the Northern Mariana Islands; and for other purposes. Introduced by REP. CHRISTOPHER D. LEON GUERRERO of Saipan, Precinct 4 (*for himself*) on October 24, 2013, referred to the Committee on Judiciary and Governmental Operations.

H. L. B. No. 18-34

To appropriate \$40,000.00 from Local License Fees collected for Poker and Pachinko Slot Machines in the First Senatorial District and for other purposes. Introduced by REP. TERESITA A. SANTOS of Rota, Precinct 7 (*for herself*) on October 24, 2013.
